

Protocol Data Breaches

1 REPORTING A BREACH

If a member suspects that a data breach has occurred within Dorans, they should report it to the board. This can be done for example by sending an email to board@dorans.nl.

2 REPORT PROCESSING

The above-mentioned will ascertain whether a data breach has in fact occurred, based on the guidelines set out by the Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens: (<https://autoriteitpersoonsgegevens.nl/sites/default/files/atoms/files/handleidingalgemeneverordeninggegevensbescherming.pdf>) (PDF is in Dutch). We will include a report in our register for data breaches.

If there is found to be a data breach, we will report this to the Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens. The board will then inform all affected members of the leak and will take precautions so a similar breach will not occur again.

3 DATA BREACHES AT THIRD PARTIES

If a data leak occurs at one of the third parties that have access to personal data, provided by Dorans, the board will inform all affected members and include this leak in our register.
